Coming to the Guild

Please do not attend if you feel unwell

Please avoid public transport if possible. If you are coming by car, street parking is available in Queen Square, but spaces are limited. Times and prices are as follows:

Mon-Fri 08.30 – 18.20 Sat 08.30 – 13.30. Maximum stay 2 hours
15 mins £1.48, 1 hour £5.92, 2 hours £11.84. Disabled free

Several car parks are located close to Queen Square: The Brunswick Centre (approx. 5 minutes' walk) and the President Hotel (approx. 2 minutes' walk) – cars only.

Entry and movement around the building

- A queuing system will be operating outside the building for entry, and all attendees will need to check in when they arrive.
- There is a one-way system operating on the ground floor, please follow the signs.
- Please use the hand gel provided in the entrance hall, and throughout the building.
- Masks (simple cloth face coverings) must be worn in the building. Please bring your own, although we have a supply should you need one.
- The cloakroom will be closed. Please only bring essentials and keep your belongings with you.
- The toilets will be open, with a queuing system and enhanced cleaning procedures in place.
- Seating in the meeting rooms will be set out to observe social distancing rules.
- All rooms should be kept well ventilated, with doors and windows open if possible.
- Please observe social distancing rules wherever possible.
